

We continue to meet with the Jewish Community Relations Council, and other coalition members on bias crimes effort. Last month we appeared on Radio One with Liz Dixson to speak about The Exchange at the Indianapolis Urban League as well as the effort to move bias crimes forward. In collaboration with the African American Coalition of Indianapolis, we engaging the Marion County Election Board to expand satellite voting options and to address centralized absentee ballot counting. Indiana has one of the most restrictive voter ID laws and has had the lowest voter turnout in the country. We believe it is important to advocate for expanding voting options and focusing on making the process more convenient for voters. We will continue to advocate toward those ends. We are also supporting the referendum on mass transit. It is an issue of equity and dignity for our citizens and is one of the most significant policy issues we can support to address socioeconomic immobility in Indianapolis.

Develop: We provide professional development and training opportunities through

monthly meetings and through a leadership program in partnership with the Kelley School of Business.



We are excited to continue our partnership with the Kelley School of Business, the Hoosier Fellows Program and the School of Public and Environmental Affairs as we kick off the next class for the Exchange Leadership Fellows Program. This program is designed to be an intergenerational conversation with leaders in business, government, nonprofit and civic organizations. Participants will leave the program with an enhanced historical context of how the city developed and is developing as well as skills to have an impact on issues that matter to you.

Serve: We coordinate community service efforts centered on the National Urban League's five pillars of focus.


